Project delivery update:

Councillor Mark Roper, cabinet member for Economic Development, Regeneration and Growth, said: "As stated in our press release on 5th January, site preparation works have now begun prior to construction. Where possible, we are keeping disruption on Temple Street itself to a minimum and we are in the process of carrying out final surveys and setting up a site compound and welfare unit nearby. Please have a look at the project webpage for more details and an estimated construction phasing plan diagram. We encourage residents and businesses to keep an eye on the webpage as it will be updated regularly as works progress."

The Project Team has been working very closely with contractors to minimise disruption to businesses, residents and visitors whilst final surveys and preliminary site work takes place and Wessex Water prepare to carry out drainage works in the area as part of the Temple Street Improvement Works.

Works have been less intrusive than initially anticipated across this initial set up period and we have therefore been able to delay the car parking suspension in line with construction (ground-breaking work) starting as per the Estimated Construction Phasing Plan on the 23 January 2023 which we hope will be received positively. We will continue to work with contractors to release parking on an ad-hoc basis as works allow, as per stated in the press release and letters sent to businesses, residents and landlords on the 5 January 2023.

Estimated construction plan update:

A small amendment has been made to the Estimated Construction Plan due to material supply chain deliveries. The latest version of this will shortly be available on the project website page – QR code and link provided below. The main change is that within the Phase2B Temple Street Improvement area, the phase I construction area will now be slightly further up from 44 – 50 Temple Street.

Please note this is still an estimate programme – durations subject to in ground findings, drainage repairs, material delivery times and is dependent on the weather (including ground temperatures required for materials to be laid and set). Printouts of this diagram can be obtained from Keynsham Town Council or via Keynsham Library.
